## PARTIAL HOSPITALIZATION PROGRAM (PHP) | (AGES 16+)

Our PHP is the most comprehensive outpatient program available, providing intensive psychotherapeutic treatment and support in a less restrictive setting than inpatient care. PHP helps prevent hospitalization and also provides a solid bridge for those stepping down from hospitalizations or residential treatment programs. PHP meets in person five days a week for six hours a day.

# INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT PROGRAM (IOP) | (AGES 16+)

Providing a higher level of support, our IOP is designed to help individuals who are experiencing an increase in distressing symptoms and behaviors or who aren't progressing in traditional outpatient services. The extra treatment and support foster meaningful improvement and create a solid foundation for clients before they transition to community treatment. IOP meets in-person or virtually three to five days a week for three hours a day.

# VIRTUAL INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT PROGRAM (V-IOP) | (AGES 16+)

Our V-IOP is a convenient and COVID-safe treatment option that mirrors the experience and support of our in-person program. V-IOP meets for three hours a day, three to five days a week.
