WHAT WE TREAT

Selah House Outpatient - Jeffersonville provides a serene, healing environment to help those who suffer from eating disorders and other co-occurring body-related issues.

LEVELS OF CARE

PARTIAL HOSPITALIZATION PROGRAM (PHP) | (AGES 12+)

PHP serves as a preventive program to hospitalization, as well as a solid bridge for those stepping down from hospitalizations or residential treatment programs. Our PHP meets in-person five days a week for six hours per day. Additionally, we have separate PHP treatment for adolescents (12 to 18 years).

INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT PROGRAM (IOP) | (AGES 12+)

Our intensive outpatient program (IOP) helps clients who are experiencing an increase in distressing symptoms/behaviors or aren't progressing in traditional outpatient services. Providing a step-down level of care from PHPs, the extra treatment fosters meaningful improvement and creates a solid foundation for clients transitioning to community treatment. Our IOP meets in-person three to five days a week for three hours per day. We also offer a separate IOP for adolescents (12 to 18 years).

EVENING VIRTUAL INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT PROGRAM (V-IOP) | (AGES 16+)

Provided throughout Indiana and Kentucky, our evening V-IOP is a convenient virtual program offered only in the evenings on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm EST.
